Re: Request for Investigation and Prosecution - Private Corporations Exercising Statutory Party and Candidate Committee Functions; Ongoing Violations of Georgia Election Code and Federal Preemptive Laws; Unconstitutionality.

Dear Attorney General Carr,

The State of Georgia is a constitutionally rogue state and you appear to be benefitting. I write to you because you have publicly expressed an interest in the constitutionality of Georgia's elections, beginning with ensuring that candidates, such as yourself, obtain only **lawful ballot access**. You are now presented with a documented opportunity to expose serious and ongoing violations of Georgia and federal law affecting every candidate who has interacted with an entity styling itself as "Georgia Republican Party, Inc." **to which you were instructed to write your check to "qualify."** This corporation also operates under the authority of "Republican National Committee CORPORATION" (est. April 8, 2022; see attached DC FOIAs). By exercising public jurisdiction and control of elections, these corporations are destroying our system of government by forms of coercive force and acts more egregious. Actions to support the U.S. Constitution must be exercised. And, you have responsibility.

I. The Core Problem in Georgia

By ultra vires act of state officials, a **private corporation** has seized the *name, assets, statutory privilege, and federal tax identity historically associated with the Georgia Republican Party* and is presenting itself to candidates, election officials, and the public as though it were the lawful "state party committee" contemplated by Georgia and federal election statutes.

This private corporation:

- Directs candidates to write qualifying-week checks payable to “**Georgia Republican Party, Inc.**” (see attached letter and payment instructions);
- Appears in Georgia Ethics filings as the recipient of qualifying fees; and
- Files with the Federal Election Commission under the name “**Georgia Republican Party Inc.**” listing Laurie L. McClain as Treasurer and Karen Hentschel as Custodian of Records. They certify filing under penalty!

Ms. Karen Hentschel, identified in that filing as custodian of federal records, but is legally only an employee of the corporation, has further stated in writing: “As requested our FEIN number is 58-0614987,” identifying herself as Accounting Director of Georgia Republican Party.

According to May 2025 statements of Ms. Laurie McClain (CFO of Georgia Republican Party, Inc. with the Ga Corporations Division), this same FEIN is being used by “Georgia Republican Party, Inc.” This appears to be an ongoing theft.

These conditions are not conjectural. They are filed broadly as verified evidence.

II. Georgia Law Violations Involving Fraud-Based Qualifications

1. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-50(a)(2)

The Secretary of State must recognize and deal with *political parties* only as defined by statute—not private corporations. Allowing a private corporation to stand in the place of a party committee violates this provision.

2. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-131 (Qualifying Fees)

Qualifying fees are paid pursuant to statute to a lawful committee of a political—not to a private corporation. Requiring candidates to tender checks to a private corporate entity is **prima facie unlawful**.

3. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-153 (Ballot Access Conditions)

Conditioning ballot access on approaching and swearing to a private corporation is not authorized by Georgia law.

4. Fraud on the Inducement

Candidates are induced during qualifying week to believe they are interacting with a lawful political party committee when, in fact, they are transacting with a private corporation. Candidates must cut their checks to the Georgia Republican Party, Inc.

No corporation has statutory power to grant ballot access, based on fundamental rules of statutory interpretation. See **O.C.G.A. § 21-2-154(a) and § 21-2-110(f)**. Further, under Georgia law, a candidacy procured through fraud is void. Every candidate who relied on this misrepresentation, either intentionally or through undetected fraud, is therefore **disqualified** from ballot access as a matter of law. **ALL AFFIDAVITS AND CERTIFICATES OF GEORGIA REPUBLICAN PARTY, INC. ARE VOID.**

III. Georgia Campaign Finance Law Violations Create Fraud-Based Funds

O.C.G.A. § 21-5-40 — Definition of Political Committee

Georgia law defines a political committee as: “any partnership, committee, club, association, organization, or similar entity **other than a business entity** which makes a contribution.”

At the same time, O.C.G.A. § 21-5-3 defines “business entity” broadly to include corporations, including nonprofit corporations.

This statutory framework, therefore, **prohibits a corporate entity from functioning directly as a candidate campaign committee** collecting and expending funds for the purpose of electing a candidate. Examples of corporations posing as candidate committees include Carr for Georgia, Inc., Friends of Franklin, Inc., and JFK for Georgia, Inc. There are hundreds and the prohibition appears to also

include Georgians First Leadership Committee, Inc. and WBJ Leadership Committee, Inc. It is strongly encouraged that the possibility of forms of money-laundering, mail fraud, and racketeering be investigated. There are plenty of red flags.

IV. Federal Campaign Finance Law Concerns

Corporate Contribution and Expenditure Prohibition (Tillman Act)

52 U.S.C. § 30118 (Enacted as positive law in 2 U.S.C. § 441(b))

Federal law prohibits corporate contributions or expenditures in connection with elections for public office.

The statute provides:

- (a) It is unlawful ... **for any corporation whatever**, or any labor organization, to make a contribution or expenditure in connection with any election at which presidential and vice presidential electors or a Senator or Representative in, or a Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, Congress are to be voted for, or in connection with any primary election ... held to select candidates for any of the foregoing offices, or for any candidate, political committee, or other person knowingly to accept or receive any contribution prohibited by this section, or any officer or any director of any corporation or any national bank or any officer of any labor organization to consent to any contribution or expenditure by the corporation, national bank, or labor organization, as the case may be, prohibited by this section.

The law defines “contribution or expenditure” broadly to include:

- direct or indirect payments
- distributions
- advances or deposits of money
- services or anything of value made in connection with an election.

Congress expressly allowed corporate political participation only through **separate segregated funds** (PAC structures). Georgia Republican Party, Inc. is not one.

Since the corporate entities are operating in place of the **campaign committees handling contributions and expenditures for a candidate**, rather than administering a segregated political fund, compliance is lacking under federal law.

The statute also makes it unlawful for any candidate or committee to **knowingly accept a prohibited contribution**. Ballot access directly through the corporation, conducted in a public building, appears to be an item or service of value.

V. Federal Criminal Law Controls — Not State Agency Policy

The controlling authority is **52 U.S.C. § 30118**, rooted in the **Tillman Act of 1907**, which criminalizes corporate contributions or expenditures in connection with federal elections and strictly limits corporate involvement in political committees except through narrow, segregated-fund mechanisms.

No regulation, advisory opinion, or state agency policy can override this statute.

Where a private corporation: 1) Claims the identity of a party committee, 2) Collects money in connection with elections, and 3) Exercises control over candidate access to the ballot, the conduct squarely implicates federal criminal prohibitions and conspiracy against federally protected voting rights.

VI. Felony Prohibition on Private Funding of Election Administration

O.C.G.A. § 21-2-18

Georgia law requires that all costs and expenses related to conducting primaries and elections be paid exclusively from lawfully appropriated public funds. The statute expressly **prohibits** any county or municipal government, election official, or government employee from soliciting, accepting, or receiving any contribution, donation, service, or thing of value from a private person or entity **for the purpose of conducting elections or performing election duties**.

The statute defines “person” broadly to include corporations, associations, committees, and any nongovernmental entity.

Violation of this provision is explicitly classified as a felony, punishable by imprisonment of not less than one year and a fine of not less than \$10,000.

The involvement of private corporate entities in activities integral to election administration raises serious questions under this statute, as reciprocal actions are **outside of constitutional and lawful authority for any government or official**.

VII. Consequences

- All state and federal candidates of the GRP, Inc. wrote checks to a private corporation as a condition of ballot access, some willful of its unconstitutionality and some not.
- Officials who accepted or processed such corporate arrangements involving candidates participated in ultra vires conduct. Broad notice of these violations was given in 2024 & 2025 to nearly all counties and to state officials.
- Any event that is publicly solicited called a “primary” or “general election” or “special partisan election” in Georgia cannot be held with unqualified candidates of a corporate government monopoly.
- Georgia is forced to pump the brakes on egregious constitutional injuries.

VIII. Your Unique Opportunity

As State Attorney General, you are in a position to:

1. Publicly call for an independent investigation;
2. Demand that the Secretary of State immediately suspend recognition of any private corporation claiming party status;
3. Refer this matter to appropriate state and federal prosecutors;
4. Insist that ballot access be administered strictly according to statute;
5. Challenge candidates who participated in this conspiracy against rights;
6. Be a Hero instead of a Zero.

All Georgia citizens have a **basic right to a lawful elective franchise**, including the right to hold office **unless disqualified by the Constitution and laws**. O.C.G.A. § 1-2-6. This issue transcends politics and impacts all citizens, because the Article IV guarantee to representative form of government is not upheld in Georgia, in addition to its preemptive supporting laws. There are plenty of public societal indicators that civil rights are also being obliterated, because fundamental rights are not upheld.

Will Georgians allow those in power to defy state and federal law, one of whom is State of Georgia Attorney and CEO of Georgia Republican Party, Inc. Joshua R. McKoon? In addition to his public role in granting federal and state ballot access, which have long been classified as state action, he has legal oversight of millions of dollars in federal education grants as General Counsel for the Technical College System of Georgia. His corporate and conflicting actions appear to require that he be referred to the U.S. Office of Special Counsel.

I respectfully request that you review the enclosed documentation and act.

**** In the event that a candidate pays his or her qualifying fee with a check that is subsequently returned for insufficient funds, the Secretary of State shall automatically find that such candidate has not met the qualifications for holding the office being sought, unless the bank, credit union, or other financial institution returning the check certifies in writing by an officer's or director's oath that the bank, credit union, or financial institution erred in returning the check.**

5. **Qualifying In Person:** you **will** need to bring a completed Declaration of Candidacy & Affidavit. **PLEASE PRINT LEGIBLY**. If you do not bring one, you will be able to complete one at the Check In station. You do not need to have it pre-notarized, we will have notaries on site at qualifying.
6. **Qualifying by a Representative:** You must send an email to karen@gagop.org to notify her that you will be sending a representative to file your qualifying paperwork on your behalf. You will need to bring the signed representative letter by the candidate authorizing you to file on their behalf along with both the Declaration of Candidacy and Affidavit and the Georgia Republican Party Oath Statement both completed in full, signed and notarized and a check for the qualifying fee.

Stations – 3 Step Process:

1. **Check In:** Present your Government issued photo I.D., Declaration of Candidacy and Affidavit Form and Check made Payable to Georgia Republican Party for correct qualifying fee. We will verify your voter registration in SOS software and enter your data into the software. If you did not bring a completed Declaration, we will have you complete it while you are at the check in desk. We will then print a summary report for you to review and sign.
 - * *Declaration of Candidacy and Affidavit – completed, **Do Not Sign until you are in front of a Notary***
 - * *Summary Print Out page - signed*
2. **Notary:** You will sign all documents in front of the notary and have them notarized. You will also present your check to pay the qualifying fee to confirm correct amount:
 - * *Present Government issued photo I.D.*
 - * *Declaration of Candidacy and Affidavit*
 - * *Georgia Republican Party Oath*
 - * *Pay Qualifying Fee*
3. **Copier:** You will receive a photocopy of all your documents and your check for your qualifying fee.

GA Secretary of State Website: Go to www.sos.ga.gov before you leave the Capitol to confirm your name appears as a qualified candidate.

State Ethics: If you are a new candidate for the first time, please stop by the State Ethics table outside of the doors in the hallway for information on registering with them. ***Before accepting or expending campaign funds you must file a Declaration of Intent (DOI) with the State Ethics.***

(a) The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of one person whose name is John Padgett and whose address is P.O. Box 550008, Atlanta, GA 30355. The Board of Directors shall exercise all of the powers of the Corporation, including the adoption and amendment of the Bylaws of the Corporation. The number, qualifications, terms of office, and manner of selection of members of the Board of Directors shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

(b) No person who is serving or has served as a member of the Board of Directors shall have any liability to the Corporation for monetary damages for any action taken, or any failure to take any action, as a member of the Board of Directors, except liability:

- (i) for any appropriation, in violation of his or her duties, of any business opportunity of the Corporation;
- (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law;
- (iii) for the types of liability set forth in Sections 14-3-860 through 14-3-864 of the Georgia Nonprofit Corporation Code; or
- (iv) for any transaction from which such person derived an improper personal benefit.

The limitation of liability conferred in this Article shall be in addition to and not in lieu of all other limitations, immunities, and indemnities conferred by law, these Articles, and the Bylaws of the Corporation.

PURPOSE.

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated to conduct and carry on the not for profit work of the Corporation exclusively as a political organization in a manner consistent with section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code") and any Treasury Regulations promulgated thereunder and for such related purposes as may be permitted to corporations which are organized under the Georgia Nonprofit Corporation Code and which are described in the aforesaid provision of the Code.

NO PRIVATE INUREMENT.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation or its assets upon dissolution shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth above. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 527 of the Code.

AMENDMENT.

These Articles of Incorporation may be altered, amended or repealed as specified in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
AND STATEMENT OF CONVERSION

TO: Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs
District of Columbia Government
Corporations Division

The undersigned, acting as the Incorporator of a nonprofit corporation under the provisions of the District of Columbia Business Organizations Code (D.C. Code, Title 29) (the "Act"), adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is Republican National Committee (the "Corporation").

SECOND: The Corporation is incorporated as a nonprofit corporation under D.C. Code, Title 29, Chapter 4.

THIRD: The period of the Corporation's duration is perpetual.

FOURTH: The purpose of the Corporation shall be to exercise the general management of the Republican Party, based upon rules adopted by the Republican National Convention, and to promote the election of Republican candidates under rules set forth for entities recognized as nonprofit political organizations under Section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in effect or as hereafter may be amended (the "Code"), and to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Act. The Corporation shall be registered as a political committee with the Federal Election Commission.

In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall have all the general powers enumerated in Section 29-403.02 of the Act as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended.

In addition to the general powers enumerated in Section 29-403.02 of the Act, the Corporation shall have the power to receive contributions and make expenditures in accordance with the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and any and all other federal, state or local laws which apply to its activities in supporting Republican candidates for public office.

FIFTH: The Corporation is not authorized to issue shares of stock.

SIXTH: The Corporation shall have members. The qualifications for membership, and the rights and privileges of members, shall be set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

SEVENTH: The Corporation shall be a member-governed corporation subject to the provisions of D.C. Code Section 29-401.50.

EIGHTH: The powers of the Corporation shall be exercised, and its affairs conducted, by a board of directors of the Corporation (the "Board of Directors") who shall be designated in the manner provided for from time to time in the Bylaws of the Corporation. The number of directors may be increased or decreased pursuant to the Bylaws of the Corporation, but shall not be less than the minimum number of directors required by law.

NINTH: By filing these Articles of Incorporation, the Republican National Committee, a District of Columbia Unincorporated Nonprofit Association, is incorporating and converting to the Corporation under Section 29-204.01 of the Act. The Plan of Conversion was approved in accordance with the Act.

TENTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Corporation, including provisions for distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation, are as follows:

A. The Corporation shall not solicit or accept funds from foreign nationals, federal government contractors, national banks, or corporations organized by an act of Congress.

B. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any director or officer of the Corporation or any other private individual, except that the Corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to or for the Corporation and make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article FOURTH hereof.

C. In the event of dissolution or final liquidation of the Corporation, the remaining assets of the Corporation shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities and obligations of the Corporation, be distributed as the Board of Directors shall determine and in accordance with applicable law and regulations.

ELEVENTH: The address, including street and number, of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 1025 Connecticut Avenue, N.W., Suite 712, Washington, DC 20036, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is COGENCY GLOBAL INC.


